
## **Purposes for Assessment: Data-Informed Instruction**

## Data tells us <u>a</u> story of student learning and growth, and it informs our decision making to support that very continuous learning and growth


- Reflective practice for growth

# New York State Next Generation Learning Standards Implementation Timeline





  - Algebra I students do not sit for the Math 8 assessments
  - Only non-accelerated students sit for the Math Assessment
  - High test refusal rate 39%

















  - SUPA Sociology



### **Science Research**

- 5 Regeneron STS winners in 7 years (including 3 years in a row)
- Pelham had 3 Regional WESEF finalists that traveled to ISEF last year.
- In recent years, Pelham students have been published in major trade journals highlighting post doctoral level research.
- Most science research entries into the Westchester
   Science and Engineering Fair
- PMS program has also won awards in the Regeneron equivalent competition for that level (Broadcom)
- Our entire science K-12 spiral has integrated the scientific practices (Science 21 and OpenSciEd)

- Strong and impressive performing and fine arts program
- Robust extra-curricular club activities offered at the elementary level including:
  - Newspaper
  - Spelling Bee
  - Makerspace
  - o 24 Club
  - Perennial Math
  - Student Government

- 22 clubs offered and well-attended at PMS
- 48 clubs offered and well-attended at PMHS
- Rigorous athletic program 76 interscholastic sports offered
  - o 359 students in 7-8th grade
  - o 552 students in 9-12th grade

#### What the Data Tells Us:

- 77% of Grade 10-12 students took at least 1 AP exam
- Total AP enrollment increased to 492 students
- 83% of PMHS AP students achieved 3+ on their AP exams
- 223 PMHS students are AP Scholars
  - 87 AP scholars
  - 48 AP scholars with Honor
  - 88 AP scholars with Distinction
- PMHS mean scores exceed NY and/or Global Averages for 19 AP exams
- The average score across all AP exams taken by PMHS students in SY 23-24 was
   3.5
- 67% of students in the Class of 2024 received at least one score of 4 or higher on at least one AP exam at some point during high school
- 72% of the class of 2024 took at least one AP in their senior year



# In Summary



- State assessment data provides the District with information regarding how students performed on a specific assessment on a specific date

- Performance report includes summative and performance assessment data
